



ESALIENS MACRO OPPORTUNITIES BOND

investor profile

The sub-fund is targeted at an investor who:

- is seeking to achieve a rate of return higher than global debt securities indices within 2-year periods;
- is looking for a fund with an active and flexible investment policy focused on opportunities;
- accepts moderate investment risk associated with investments in government and non-government debt securities issued in different countries and denominated in different currencies as well as financial derivative instruments.

The sub-fund may be intended, among other things, for systematic savings within long-term saving and pension programmes (CPO, IKE, IKZE). The sub-fund performance should not be assessed in periods shorter than 2 years.

investment process

Model structure: 100% – units of the Legg Mason Western Asset Macro Opportunities Bond Fund, sub-fund operating within the framework of Legg Mason Global Funds plc (an umbrella fund registered in Ireland). Underlying sub-fund, the Legg Mason Western Asset Macro Opportunities Bond Fund, invests primarily in debt securities in developed and emerging markets as well as, in a great portion, in various financial derivative instruments in order to enhance the achievement of the investment target and limit risk and costs and generate additional capital appreciation or income. The Fund employs an actively managed strategy to invest in a combination of Investment Grade and high yield debt securities. The objective of the sub-fund is to generate capital appreciation by increasing the value of its investments. The sub-fund tracks as closely as possible the performance of the Legg Mason Western Asset Macro Opportunities Bond Fund. The sub-fund is actively managed.

definitions

Effective duration: Average Duration equals the weighted average maturity of all the cash flows in the portfolio and gives an indication of the sensitivity of a portfolio's bond prices to a change in interest rates. The higher the duration, the more sensitive the portfolio is to interest rate changes. Effective Duration is a calculation for bonds with embedded options (Not every portfolio will purchase bonds with embedded options). It takes into account the expected change in cash flows caused by the option, as interest rates change. If a portfolio does not hold bonds with embedded options, then the Effective Duration will be equal to the Average Duration.

Credit quality breakdown: ationally Recognised Statistical Rating Organisations (NRSROs) assess the likelihood of bond issuers defaulting on a bond's coupon and principal payments. The weighted average credit quality byWestern Asset Management assigns each security the higher rating from three NRSROs (Standard & Poor's, Moody's Investor Services and Fitch Ratings, Ltd.). If only one NRSRO assigns a rating, that rating will be used. Securities that are not rated by all three NRSROs are reflected as such. The lower the overall credit rating, the riskier the portfolio. The credit rating is expressed as a regular letter rating (from high to low quality): AAA, AA, A BBB BB D
